 - Student internships (including from Camas, Mill A, and two interns from SummerWorks doing work for the CCSW)
 - o 13 Teachers completed week-long paid construction externships with CSG
 - o Year-End CCSW report will be sent to Network participants next week
 - o 124 teachers completed CCL PD on Canvas
 - Worksite Video Learning Tour development to be used for asynchronous work and student worksite tours
- <u>Regional Updates</u>
 - Close to 7,000 students using Career Connected Storylines
 - <u>Business Engagement</u> had huge success with teacher worksite tours & career fairs prior to shutdown, virtual career panels post-shutdown
 - Recently entered a long-term partnership with ilani Casino (employ police, IT, construction, engineering)
 - <u>Burns and McDonell</u>- Offering financial support; Vickei meeting with their board next week to offer multiple entry points, will report back

- <u>Program Priorities</u> include
 - Reaching 10k students this 2020-21 year
 - Virtual Internship if you have teachers willing to explore the possibility, please reach out to Chad Mullen for support
 - Hoping to be able to return to hybrid and in-person internship structures.
 - Working with Clark College on new CL Applications
 - Working with AJAC to build registered apprenticeship program; looking for employers
 - Leading the initiative to develop a regional dual-credit cooperative
 - Workgroups have expanded from 4-5 in each mostly from Clark County, to averaging 20 people from across the region. Will begin meeting again next week, will have progress monitoring data by December on goals and progress.
