- Regional Work Plan
 - Chad will reach out to Lydia work to discuss projects for students

- Virtual internships will allow opportunities to be offered to the students most in need of them since distance is no longer an issue.
 - Plan is to transition back to hybrid/in-person internship opportunities once that is a possibility.
 - Some internships allow for the opportunity for hybrid (E.G. the intern picks up supplies/materials, and then completes the tasks internship virtually).
 - Currently districts cannot place students in hybrid or in-person internships until the students are able to return in-person to school. Higher-ed can place students.
