

My Story: A Career Connected Education

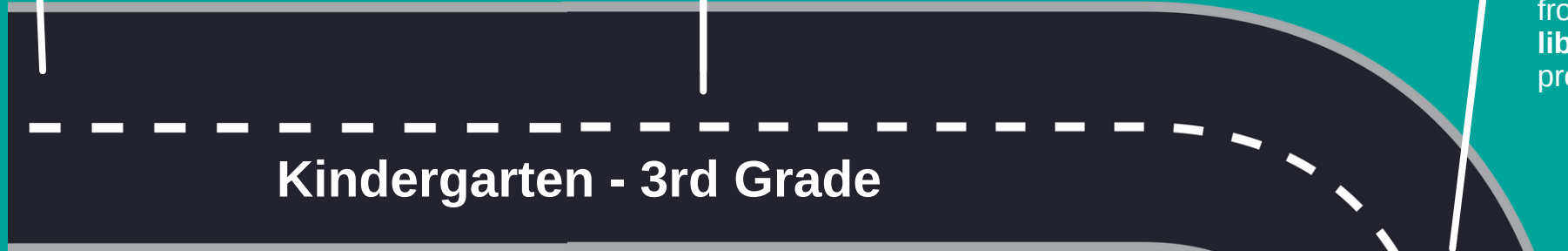
Lessons from Luisa

At **Career Day** I heard from professionals in my community about their careers.



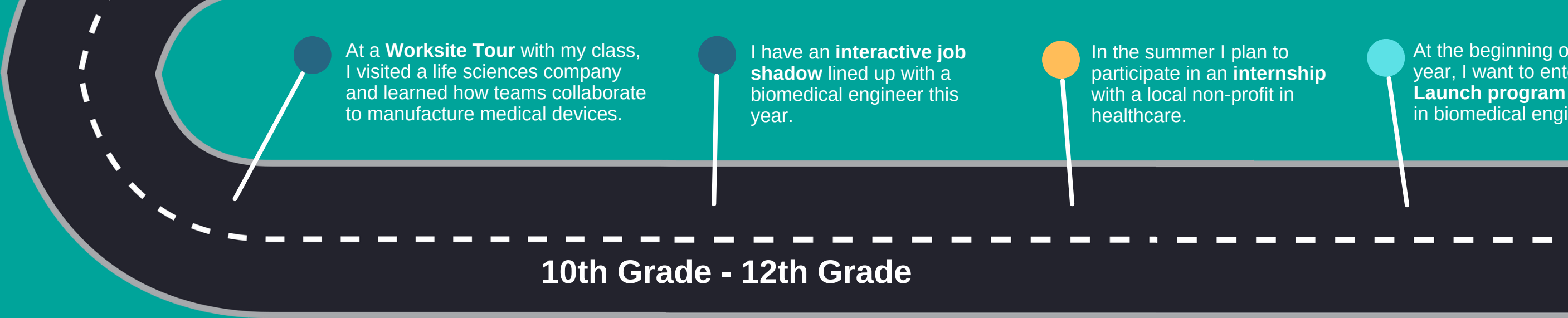
7th Grade - 9th Grade
